The Supreme Court has been presented with a suggestion to modify current Rule 69 so that a judgment debtor must receive notification of a levy by a judgment creditor so that when there is exempt property, the judgment debtor can raise the exemption before execution. The Supreme Court has considered this rule, provided a comment period for the public, and will conduct a promulgation hearing on this proposal as set forth below.

A hearing before the panel of Chief Justice Robert J. Torres, Associate Justice, F. Philip Carbullido, and Associate Justice Katherine A. Maraman, will be held at **9:30 a.m. on Friday, July 16, 2010**, in the Monessa G. Lujan Appellate Courtroom, to act on an amendment to the Guam Rules of Civil Procedure Rule 69.
