This matter comes before the court upon the Motion for Extension of Time to File Respondent’s Brief and Declaration of Darleen E. Hiton in Support of Motion for Extension of Time to File Respondent’s Brief, filed by Respondent *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* (“the Legislature”) on March 7, 2023, and the Supplemental Declaration of Darleen E. Hiton in Support of Motion for Extension of Time to File Respondent’s Brief, filed March 8, 2023. In its order filed February 18, 2023, the court invited the Legislature to participate in this matter as a respondent. Based on the position the Legislature intends to take on the issues, its deadline to file a brief is March 17, 2023. Attorney Hiton, counsel for the Legislature, asks this court to extend that deadline to April 10, 2023. In her Declaration and Supplemental Declaration, Attorney Hiton states *I Maga’hågan Guåhan* Lourdes A. Leon Guerrero (“the Governor”) does not object to the requested extension and that Attorney General Douglas Moylan, who initially consented to an extension only up to March 31, now has no objection to the requested extension of up to April 10, 2023. *See* Decl. (Mar. 7, 2023); Supp. Decl. (Mar. 8, 2023).

The court has considered the matter, and will **GRANT** the Legislature more time, though not the full extension requested. Briefing shall now proceed as follows:

The Governor’s brief must be served and filed by **March 10, 2023**.
